World Skate Clinic Junior 15+ Policy

Northern Brisbane Rollers (NBR) values and encourages the development of junior roller derby skaters in all rulesets, including the International Rules of Roller Derby ('World Skate'). This policy outlines the requirements, expectations and limitations relating to Level 3 Junior skaters aged between 15 -18 years to participate in NBR's World Skate clinics, training sessions and scrimmages with adult skaters. NBR is committed to providing a safe and supportive environment for all skaters, and requires each 15+ Junior participant and their parent or guardian to agree to this policy with the understanding Juniors will be participating in an adult environment with adult skaters.

Any deviation from the policy is to be managed by exception and subject to specific application and approval by the World Skate Coaches and Northern Brisbane Rollers Inc. Directors.

Scope - The policy is in relation to Northern Brisbane Rollers World Skate Clinic and training events only.

Definitions

JRDA - Junior Roller Derby Association

Skate Australia - The governing body of skate sport disciplines which recognises Skate Queensland as their affiliated State Sporting Organisation in Queensland.

Skate Queensland - The State Sporting Organisation recognised by Skate Australia of which the organisation is a member

Northern Brisbane Rollers Inc., NBR - The organisation. Referred to herein as NBR.

World Skate - International Rules of Roller derby

Adult - Any member 18 years old and over

Level 3 Junior – Skaters who are over the age of 15 but under the age of 18 years and have passed JRDA Level 3 assessment or equivalent.

Approved Coach - The Approved Coach conducting these sessions will have completed all required certifications, including but not limited to coaching accreditation, concussion course, first aid and who have been approved by the Northern Brisbane Rollers Directors and Coaching group.

Scrimmage session - A training session or part of a training session with team-versus-team simulated play that does not include drill-based simulated play

Skills training session - Any training session with the focus on non-team specific skills

Team training session - Any training session with the focus on a specific team, either Junior or Adult specific session

Required criteria for Level 3 Junior 15 – 18 years of age to participate in NBR World Skate events.

- Skater has successfully passed all JRDA Level 3 assessments and is considered an experienced Level 3 Junior skater

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- Has signed approval from their Junior League Coach
- Participants will only be able to attend designated world skate sessions.
- Acknowledgement and understanding from the Level 3 Junior skater and their Parent/Guardian that designated sessions will include World Skate skills training, team training and training scrimmages, alongside adult participants. Attending World Skate coaches will determine what is an acceptable level of training / scrimmage for persons in attendance.
- The World Skate coaches must be in attendance at all designated sessions and will have the discretion to alter or stop these sessions at any time to ensure the safety of all participants.
- Each Level 3 Junior skater has signed consent and agreement of this policy by their Parent/Guardian, and the attending World Skate Coach in order to be allowed to participate.

Conduct During Sessions

All skaters – Juniors and Adults – are required to conduct themselves in an appropriate manner at this event, and abide by all directions given by NBR Coaching and Directors group. As these sessions will incorporate juniors and adults, all participants need to be aware of the circumstances that occur during these sessions. World Skate coaches will ensure that conduct will be kept at an appropriate level for all skaters.

While World Skate is a full contact sport and body parts will intercept, if at any stage any person participating in the training session feels compromised as a person, we encourage you to raise the issue with any of the coaches at the training session or any member of the NBR Coaching and Directors group. Under no circumstances will any sexual harassment and inappropriate conduct be tolerated, and any incident will be dealt with in consultation of the World Skate coaches and NBR Directors.
